Rob Huyser studied economics and law at Groningen University in the Netherlands. After his master's degree in business economics, he served in the military (infantry) and started at the Ministry of Defence as a financial advisor. He later moved to the transport ministry and held positions in logistics, infrastructure, railways and international affairs. In 2005, he became head of the shipping department and later director for maritime affairs at the Ministry of Infrastructure and the Environment. In 2013, he became the Acting Director General for Civil Aviation. Mr Huyser is a member of the following institutions: the Advisory Board of the International Institute of Air and Space Law (IIASL) of Leiden University, the Advisory Council Aerospace Engineering of Delft University of Technology, the Advisory Board of the Dutch Air and Space Fund, and the Advisory Board of the Dutch Aerospace Laboratory (NLR).
